



This month the the Nursing Home Ministry will be caroling with the residents at *Serene Manor Medical Center* on December 15th at 2 pm. We invite you to join us.





And Faith Will Move Mountains

"Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

When Pastor Robert Johnson and Northwest Church of God purchased the property where the church now sits, his wish was that everyone who passed by could see the church. Unfortunately, he found that the property housed an old quarry. He was so afraid he had failed his congregation. He came everyday to walk the property and pray that he had made the right decision.

Work began and Pastor Johnson was there every day to oversee the progress that was being made. One day he called his wife, Marie, and told her work had stopped. There was a huge rock in the way and it could not be moved. The contractor had brought in the biggest piece of equipment he had, but nothing was working. It would not be moved! Sister Johnson told them to hold on, she would call him back. She got on her knees and prayed and cried out and prayed even more. Then she called Brother Johnson back.

"Tell that man to move that rock. It's going to pop right out of there like a peanut out of its shell!"

The man did as she said and Sister Johnson kept praying. About 30 minutes later, Pastor Johnson called to say that rock popped right out of the ground just like she said it would!

Sister Johnson was so committed to her faith and to her God. One day she was talking on the phone, praying and leading a friend to the Lord. Brother Robert got choked on something, so she told the person on the phone to hold on. She then went to her husband, "doubled up my fist and knocked the fire out of his back," she says. He coughed up the offending morsel and she went right back to the phone to continue praying.

Brother and Sister Johnson led Northwest Church of God for over 27 years, until Brother Robert developed Alzheimer's Disease. Their faith in God was the backbone of their ministry.
