From the Editors:

On January 19th we had the opportunity to go to Black Oak Baptist Church for a seminar, titled Make a Difference, on how to evangelize in our everyday lives. Don Sunshine taught many ways in which we can step out of our comfort zone to talk with people about Jesus. When was the last time you got to sow some gospel seed into someone's life? Has it been a few months? A few years? Maybe you've never had the courage to step out and talk with someone about Christ. No matter how long it's been for you, there is hope in knowing that you can begin now... it's not too hard! As Don says, "The biggest difference you can ever make is to take someone to heaven with you."

I know talking with someone about Christ can sometimes bring on anxiety. There are so many things we tell ourselves as to why we should keep silent.

"Someone will make fun of me."

"They won't want to hear what I have to say. My story's not that important."

"I'm not a preacher - I can't do it on my own."

These are all lies from satan to try to get us to stay silent. But we have a mandate from Jesus to go and tell the gospel story. Even if someone doesn't acept what you are saying, you can't let that stop you.

"Successful evengelism is taking the initiative to share Jesus Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit and leaving the results to God."

Don brought up a great picture analogy to help us remember our role in evangelizing. God is like a glove. The glove cannot pick up a cup of coffee. It cannot help a friend who has fallen. It cannot do anything on its own. But when the hand is put into that glove, it is dextrous and can then be useful for whatever purpose it sets out to accomplish. Our role is to be that hand. Mark 16:15 says: "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." Jesus left us with a commission to go and make disciples! He wouldn't have told us to do this if we weren't equipped to do so. So this month, show God's love to someone and share your story with them. It jut might be that one seed that takes root in their lives and helps them choose to have a relationship with Christ.
