We visited in the fall last year during revival and felt welcomed and enjoyed the worship, and the friendly atmosphere, and the personable greeting of Pastor John. A New Era at Northwest Church of God

In July of 1991, Northwest Church of God was blessed with new pastors, Dewayne and Brenda Green. They came bringing joy in the Lord and an awesome music ministry. Both Brother and Sister Green were never seen without a smile on their faces and an uplifting spirit. Along with their children, Keith and Tina, the Greens lifted the congregation in song.

They sang as a quartet with Sister Brenda accompanying them on piano. A wonderful sense of love was felt through the church. The congregation began to grow, up to an average of 180 people at the services.

A need to provide for the members began to emerge; Brenda began forming small groups for them. She started meetings for girls and for boys, both men and women had their own ministries, along with the youth and senior members. *Young at Heart* was organized with Sister Ginny Trent in charge. The adult ladies interacted with the youth in a *Little Sister* program. For the middle aged group, *The Joy Club* came into being.

During this time, the *Family Life Center* came to be. Brother Green spearheaded this mission to provide more room for the growing church. A newsletter was published keeping the members in touch with the activities in the church.

The Greens are remembered as being "good people." When a member of the church had surgery, Pastor Green insisted she use his parking space next to the door until she recovered. (There were no handicapped spaces at tht time.) He was always living the Word with his heart and actions.

The Greens ministered at *Northwest Church of God* from 1991 until 1999. They are truly a blessing for the people who know them. They also remain friends with their church family.
