- ³¹Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.
- ³² And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."
- ³³They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How can You say, 'You will be made free'?"
- ³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.
- ³⁵ And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever.
